Dear Governor Rauner:

On behalf of the Illinois Association of the Deaf (IAD), we write to you on a matter of the utmost urgency and respectfully request you sign Senate Bill 1839 (SB1839), important legislation addressing provisions and funding for telecommunications and 9-1-1 centers. Along with many Illinoisans, we ask you sign this bill into State Law at your earliest possible opportunity.

The Illinois Telecommunications Act is set to expire July 1<sup>st</sup>. This act contains the mechanism for telephone providers to collect directly from telephone subscribers and fund programs and services, including 9-1-1 and the Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation (ITAC).

Communication access should not be used as a political pawn. SB1839 is not in any way related to the general budget discussion, primarily addresses regulatory issues and extends the repeal date of the Illinois Telecommunications Act. Specifically, SB1839 ensures 9-1-1 funding remains and Deaf, DeafBlind, Late Deafened, Speech-Disabled and Hard of Hearing Illinois residents will continue to benefit from the Illinois Relay Phone System and numerous telecommunication devices ITAC distributes.

With funding mechanisms established in the Telecommunications Act, ITAC has been a valuable resource to the greater community since 1988. ITAC continues to distribute various telecommunication devices, including TTYs, alerting devices, DeafBlind communicators, etc. We need your support to ensure the community's communication access standards and experiences are not diminished or disrupted.

We appreciate your recognition of the time-sensitive nature of our request and understanding of the positive impacts this legislation has on Deaf, DeafBlind, Late Deafened, Speech-Disabled and Hard of Hearing Illinois residents. Thank you for your consideration of our request.
